

Effective July 7, 2021, the Lakewood Court has adopted the facial mask policy that was issued on June 9, 2021 by the Cuyahoga County government and Common Pleas Court. The complete county mask policy is located at the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas website and is available upon request from the Lakewood Municipal Court Clerk of Court Office.

Generally, facial masks are required at all times upon entering the building for the Lakewood Municipal Court. This includes the lobby, courtroom, and building interior hallways. For all Lakewood Court and Lakewood City employees who have provided proof of vaccination to either the Clerk of Court or the City of Lakewood HR Department, a facial mask is optional. A “No Mask” exemption sticker may be obtained from the Lakewood Municipal Court Clerk of Court Office as long as available.

Similarly, attorneys who have met the requirements of the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court and have obtained a “No Mask” exemption sticker may choose not to wear a mask. In accordance with the Common Pleas Court policy, the sticker must be visible on the attorney’s identification card to be exempt from the mandatory mask policy.

This policy remains in effect until further court order.
